Special Pre-Release Screening of *Brothers at War* to Show in Akron

Screening Followed by Meet and Greet with

Akron, Ohio (March 13, 2009) – An eye-opening and sentimental look into the life of American soldiers in Iraq will fill the screen at Regal Interstate 18 Theater on Saturday, March 21 at 12:55 P.M. Screening only tickets can be purchased at the Regal Interstate 18 box-office for \$6.50.

"Tickets to this exclusive screening and meet and greet are very reasonably priced because our goal is to foster an Akron-area appreciation for independent cinema," Eric Vaughan, also a managing member of New Akropolis and Executive Director of The Akron Cinema Society said.
